Welcome to WFCG 2016

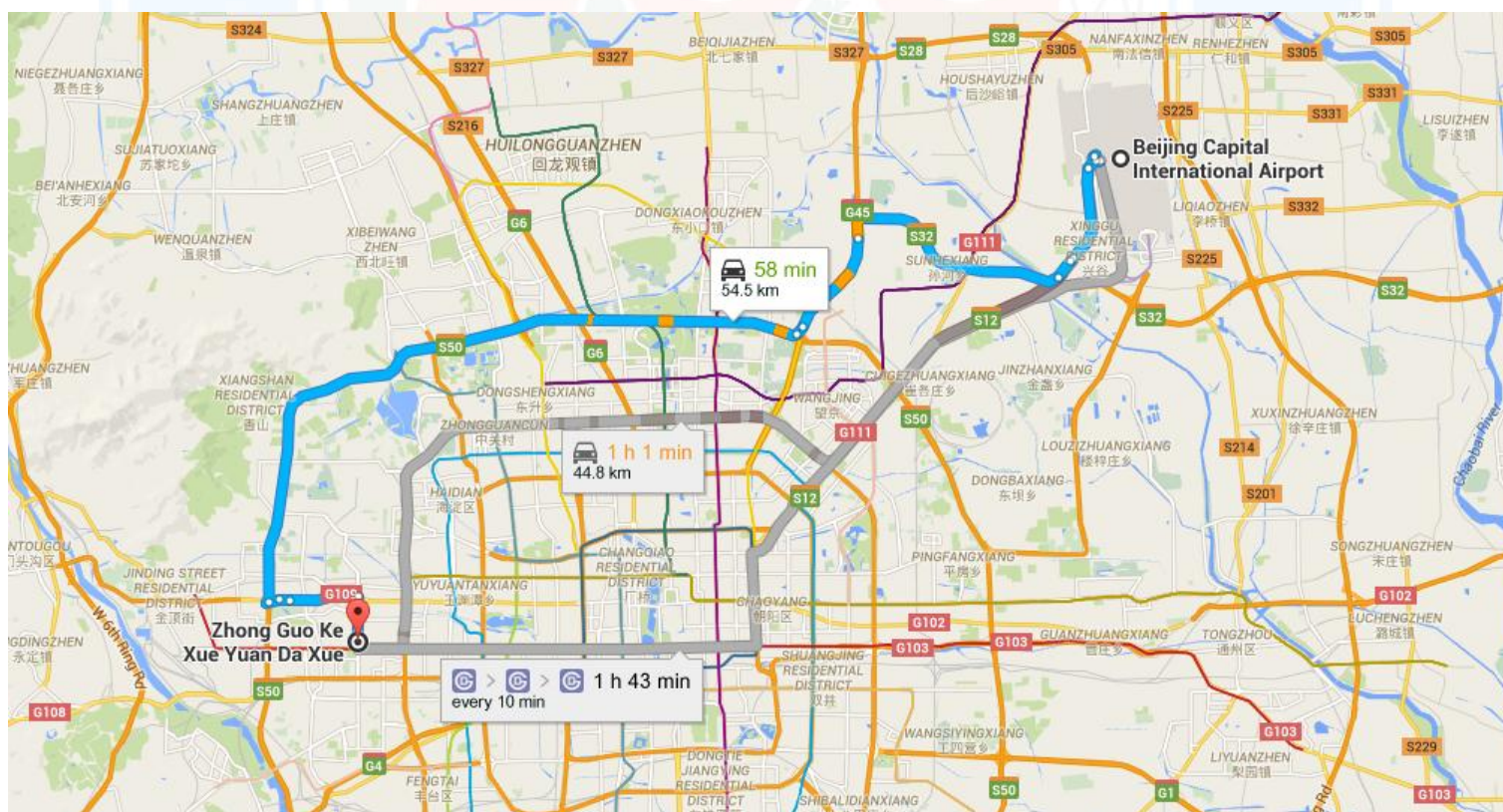
